GARDEN PANEL

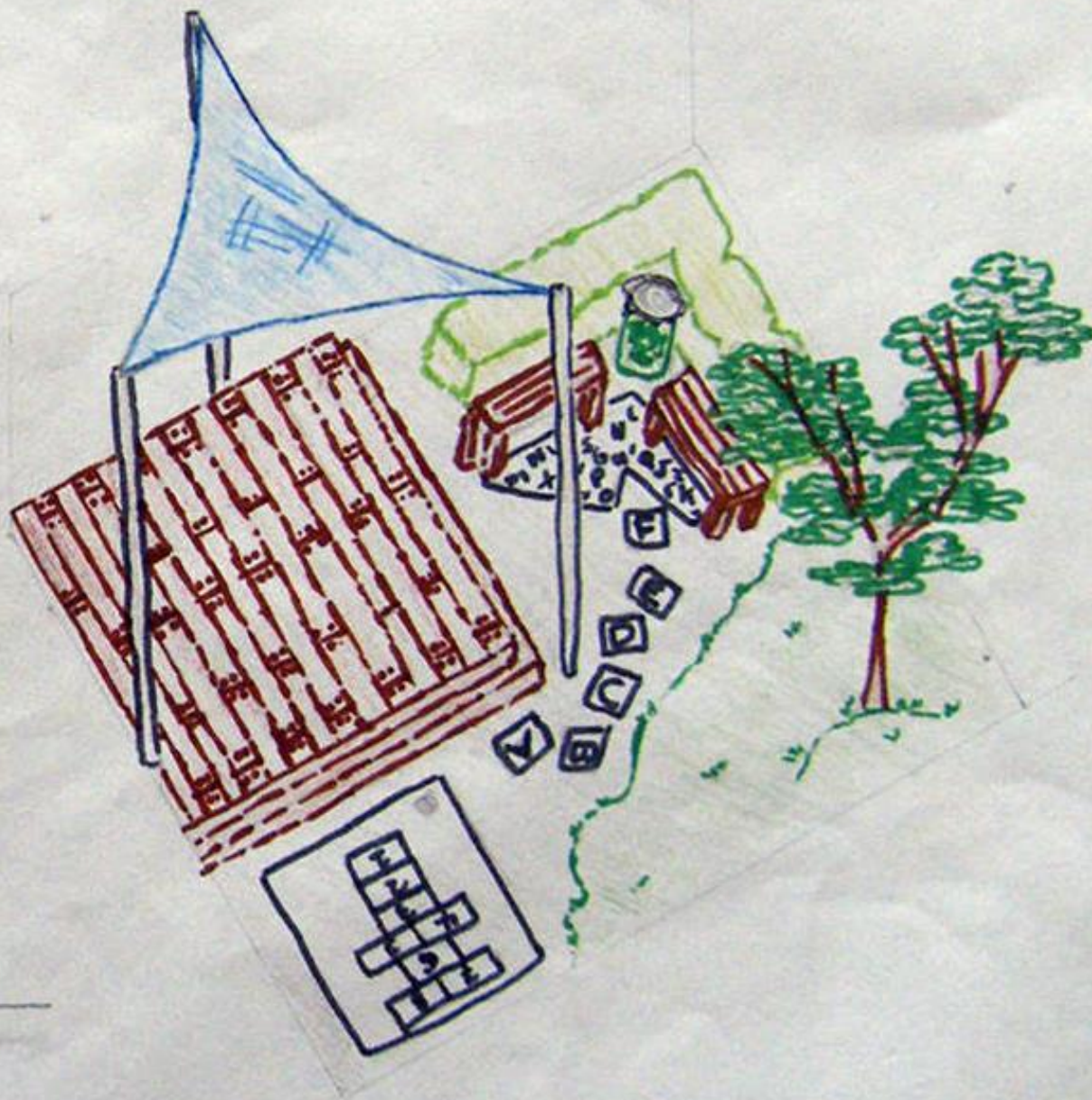


This design provides two seats which are 400mm by 1.5m long. Each seat fits three children which are 500mm wide. Because the average size for a child is very small, the seat needs to be about 410mm high for ergonomic reasons so their legs/feet are stable on the concrete surface.

In between each chair is a rubbish bin. This helps to encourage children not to litter. Behind is a right angled, neatly trimmed hedge. It provides boundaries so children know they're not allowed beyond that point. It has an interesting texture with coarse leaves. There are educational stepping stones leading from the eating area to the deck. The stepping stones have a rough texture with a darker shade of grey which outlines the stepping stones to make them easier to recognize. The deck provides another seating area. It has a large share cloth so that it encourages children to keep cool, but most importantly, safe from sun!

I have used an abstract shape edge of grass that is provided by intersecting arcs making Tangent points.

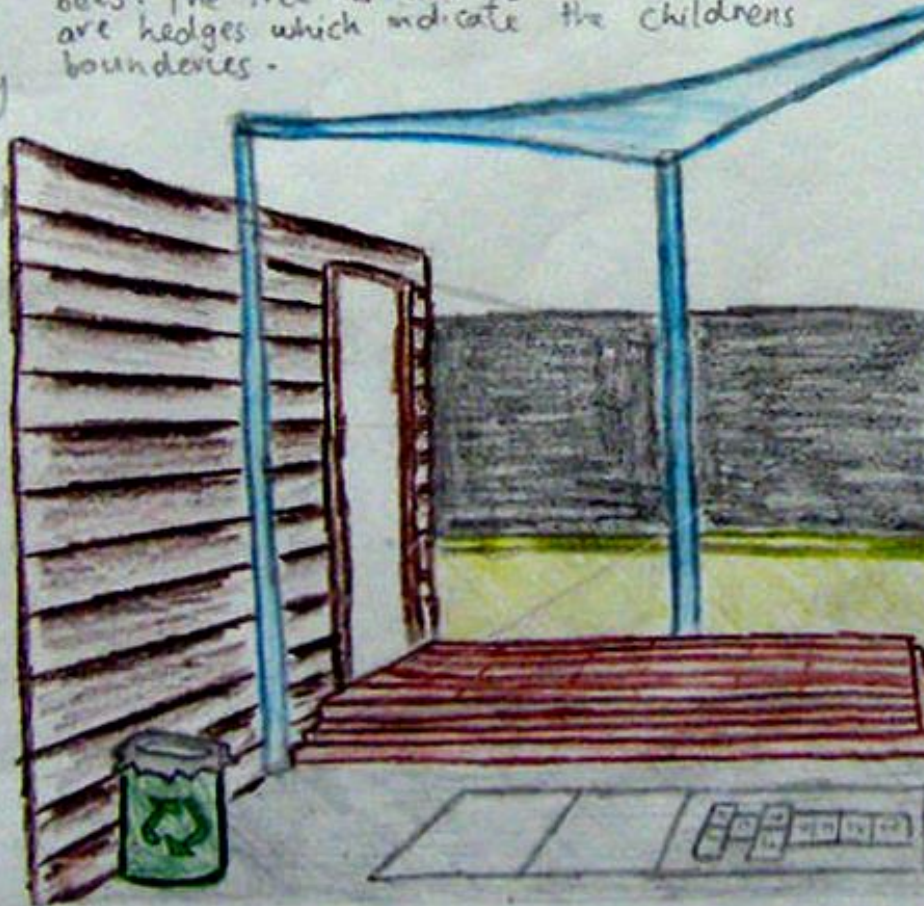

GARDEN MOD

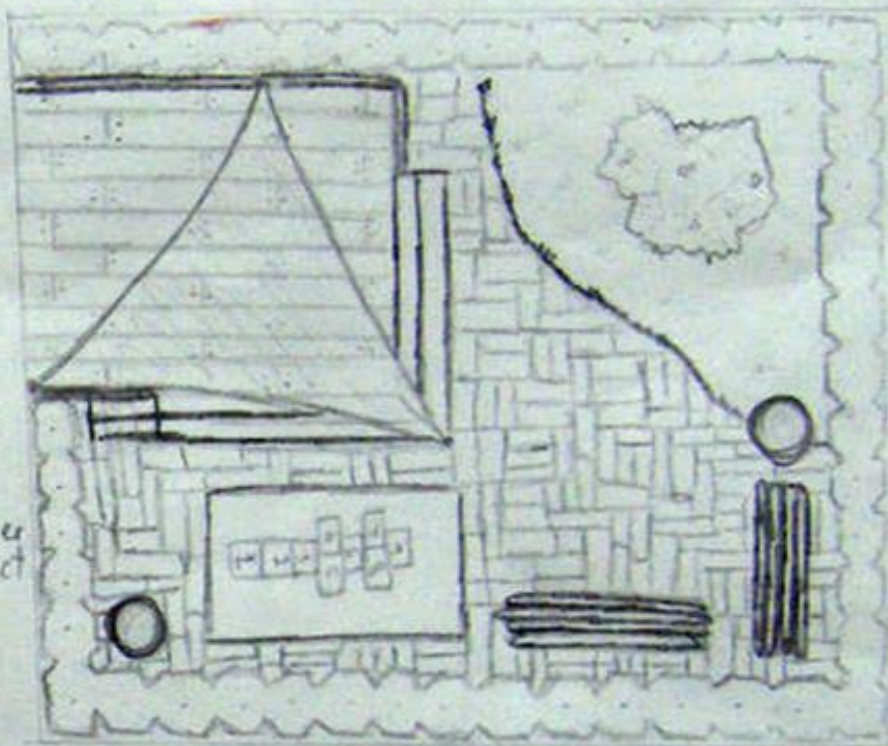
In this pictorial sketch of my garden, I have uttered the concrete pavers to make one whole expanse of concrete with rectangular stepping stones that breaks it up visually. I have taken away a chair to make more space for children to play. The shape outside of the grass area is made by tangent arcs. I have added an extra game alongside the hopscotch area for children to play.

I have used the deck from my to provide transition between inside the & outdoors. The children are able to be on the deck just incase it is muddy. I have shade cloth from my first concept. It provides children in summer days. The garden is which means there is a less possibility that one downside to this is if children trip there is a 90% possibility they may hurt. I have provided the children with a small educational game which may help children. Also, two rubbish bins have been provided kids not to litter. Two seats approximately 2m can fit up to 4 children. Each child is approx wide. There is a patch of grass with a row of the patch. Children have to be wary that bees. The tree is another source of shade. Sun are hedges which indicate the childrens boundaries.
